No Open Bowling March 11 and 18

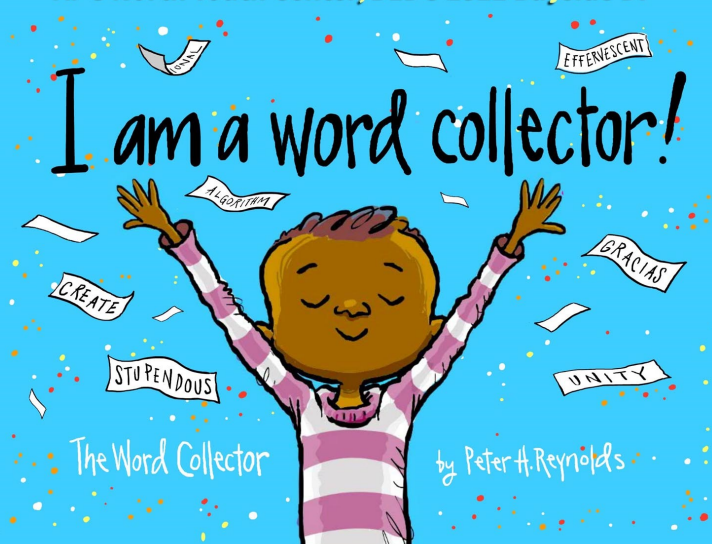
