DO YOU NEED TO WEAR A MASK?

A CHART TO HELP ANSWER YOUR MASKING QUESTIONS

ARE YOU...

FULLY VACCINATED

(RECEIVED ALL DOSES OF RESPECTIVE VACCINE AND ARE TWO WEEKS BEYOND FINAL VACCINATION DOSE)

No longer required to wear a mask indoors or outdoors at Department of Defense facilities unless otherwise stated for specific locations/entities.



NOTE: All DOD personnel should continue to comply with CDC and installation guidelines regarding areas where masks should be worn, including airports, child development centers and medical facilities.

NOT VACCINATED AND/OR PARTIALLY VACCINATED

ARE YOU...

OUTDOORS

Mask wear is required at all times with the following exceptions for temporary removal:

- Exercising alone or with members of household
- Driving alone or with members of household
- Completing organized PT
- Within Army owned/leased home area maintaining social distancing or with members of household
- Medical exemption

INDOORS

Mask wear is required at all times with the following exceptions for temporary removal:

- Within an enclosed office with the door closed
- Eating and/or drinking
- Medical exemption
