The Recreational Lodging facilities collectively consist of 185 single-occupant rooms. These units are furnished and offer private bath, hook-up for basic cable, kitchenette and closet space in select buildings. Additionally, BLDG 4316 has internet installed throughout the building. Each building has a laundry room with 4 washers and 4 dryers. All facilities are adequately furnished and will vary by facility. Each facility offers a well-lit parking area for tenants.



General Information

-Eligibility requirements are verified at the time of check in and can be found in AR 215-1 Chapter 7 (Active Duty Military, Retired Military, DoD Civilian, and Full Time Contractors on Aberdeen Proving Ground)

-Monthly rent is taken automatically on the 15th of every month (billing period is always the 1st - 30th/31st)

-Tenants are NOT to remove furniture from the rooms.

-Final clearing of a room will need a notice of at least 2 weeks in advance.

-Pets are prohibited (this includes any living creature).

-Kitchen grease needs to be disposed properly. You are NOT permitted under any circumstances to dump grease down the drain.

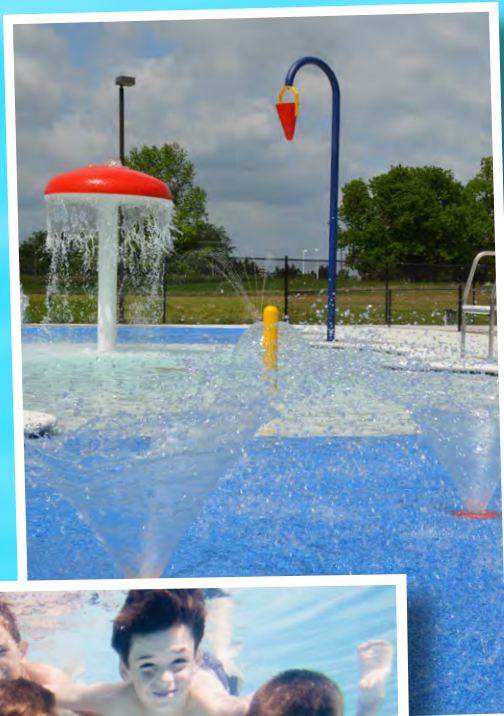

IMPORTANT POLICY INFORMATION

- Facilities and free programs for ID card holders only.
- ID card checks and swipe in at each use required when entering facility
- Patron eligibility IAW AR 215-1, table 7
- Locker facilities provided at each facility. Lockers are for daily use only and locks are not provided. Bags may not be stored on the floor in the fitness equipment areas.
- During peak participation times or when individuals are waiting to use cardiovascular machines, there is a 20-minute time limit on each piece of equipment.
- Eye protection is required (and provided) by all racquetball players.
- Youth aged 15 and under must be accompanied by eligible parent/guardian and participate with/be in line of sight at all times. No strollers or child carriers are allowed in any exercise or play area.

School Liaison Services (K-12) provide a communicative link between the Military community and the local public school system. Tutoring information is also available.

IMPACT AID SURVEY

- Federal Impact Aid is a law that provides a way for the federal government to **reimburse local school districts** for the loss of property and business tax support associated with federally connected students residing on/off base in the district.
- The funding that your child's school receives in Impact Aid **directly impacts his or her education** by providing replacement funding for operating expenses such as materials, equipment, staff, special education programming, and building improvements as part of the general funding of the district.

What Can I Do As A Parent?

Each year your child receives a **Federal Survey Form** that requests confidential information regarding his/her federal connection (including military and civilian family members). Simply by thoroughly completing and promptly returning this brief survey, you contribute to your child's school funding!

- Incomplete surveys cannot be submitted for Impact Aid; thereby creating a loss of funding for the district.
- Information provided is protected under Privacy Laws.

Surveys are given out in the First Quarter of the school year.



Child & Youth Sports

YEAR –AT-A-GLANCE SPORTS & FITNESS

The Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) Child and Youth Services CY5 Sports & Fitness program offers various opportunities for children to participate in sports. The program provides support for children ages 3-18 years to encourage healthy, life-long habits.

Team sports are only available with the participation of volunteer coaches and assistants. Team sports practices held weekdays Monday through Thursday with ages 4-10 at 5:30 and ages 11-15 at 6:30 (subject to change based on volunteer availability). Coaches are trained and certified by the National Alliance of Youth Sports (NAYS) and must have a completed background check. Players must be registered with CY5 in order to enroll in a sport. Sports Physicals are good for 1 year. Summer is the best time to get sports physicals for school year.

ACS offers a place to find the type of support needed for the enhancement of individuals and Families. We invite you to visit and utilize the many services and opportunities provided to help you maintain high levels of readiness and resilience.

Army Family Action Plan (AFAP)

The Army Family Action Plan provides a way for Soldiers, Family members and Civilian employees to let the Army leadership know what works, what does not work, and how things can be changed to improve the quality of life within the Army community.

1. You Tell Us What You Think – *Using submission forms found throughout the APG Community and on the APG website, submit your ideas, concerns, or suggestions.*
2. AFAP Listens and Acts – *Once an issue is received, it is reviewed by local volunteers, discussed at monthly forums, and submitted for action at the APG annual AFAP Conference.*
3. Together We Find A Solution – *Although some issues take time or are proven unattainable, every issue is reviewed, monitored, and tracked until a resolution is found. Most issues can be handled locally and are sent to the appropriate directorate for resolution. Those issues beyond the scope of FORSCOM may then be forwarded on to the Headquarters, Department of the Army (HQDA) AFAP Conference.*

Army Volunteer Corps 410-278-2500

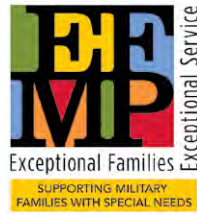

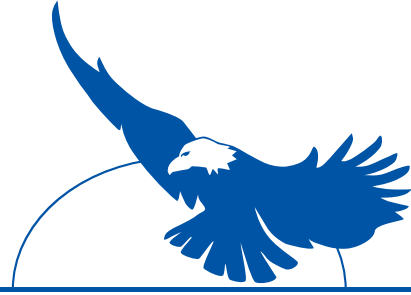
