

Official Rules

Overview

The 2020 Bracket Challenge, which is a competition based on results of the 2020 NCAA[®] Division I Men's College Basketball Tournament (the "**Tournament**"). On March 15, 2020, the Tournament's selection committee will seed the qualifying college basketball teams that will participate in the Tournament. Participants will attempt to select/pick the winning team for each of the games of the Tournament presented on the CBS Sports Service in the form of a bracket (the "**Bracket(s)**"). Participants will earn points for each winning team correctly picked through their Bracket. The number of points awarded for each correct pick of a winning team of the Tournament will increase with each round of the Tournament. The exact number of points and how they are awarded in this tournament bracket is set forth in the 'Making Picks' section below.

No Cost/Winning prize

First 100 brackets will be accepted. Limit one bracket per team

First place team will earn a spot on the tournament bracket challenge plaque, additional prizes may consist of merchandise. When there is more than one winner of a single prize, merchandise will be determined by a coin toss.

First place ties will be determined by the predicted final score of the tournaments championship game. (Closest entry to the final score without going over)

Outline

This tournament challenge is set forth as a team building event. Each entry must consist of five individuals and meet the required criteria of eligibility. Team members and organization name must be identified. Entries are limited to one per team.

The Administrator

Brewner Lanes management will serve as the Administrator of the tournament bracket challenge and will be solely responsible for resolving any disputes that arise regarding violations of the rules.

Eligibility

The tournament bracket is open to persons who: (a) are legal residents of the United States, (b) are at least 18 years of age or older (c) authorized patrons (active duty, dependents, retirees or DOD civilians)

MWR employees working directly within Brewner Lanes Bowling Center are prohibited from participating.

Signing Up

Brackets can be picked up at Brewner Lanes Bowling Center between 11 March 2020 and 18 March 2020

All tournament brackets must be received by the designated tournament bracket challenge administrator no later than 3:00 pm ET 18 March 2020

Making Picks

Note: The 61st through 64th teams will be determined by the first four (4) games of the Tournament, played on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 and Wednesday, March 18, 2020. Those games will not be counted in this tournament bracket challenge. Prior to completion of those games, the 61st through 64th teams will be listed on our brackets as "Team 1/Team 2", and Participants are free to pick "Team 1/Team 2" in the first round.

Participants must enter their projected winning teams of the 63 remaining games of the Tournament, round by round, beginning with the tournament's first round. The Administrator will weigh predictions for each successive round more heavily than the previous round, in accordance with the table below. Points will be awarded by multiplying your number of correct predictions of winning teams in each round of the bracket challenge, weight assigned to each applicable round. For example, you would receive five (5) points for five correct predictions of winning teams in the first round, and ten (10) points for five correct predictions of winning teams in the second round. You will receive an individual score for each of the six tournament rounds (rounds 1 to 6) in the bracket challenge and an overall score, which is the combined total of your individual round's scores.
