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Picnic Area Policies

- 1. Request can be made starting 1 February for Active Duty and 1 March for DOD Civilians, Veterans, Retired Military and APG Contractors.
- 2. Half deposit fee is required to hold date of event, upon written request and approval refund permitted with exception of \$10.00.
- 3. Patron will be contacted 48 hours prior to the reservation to finalize the reservation with full payment.
- 3. Cancellation date is seven days prior. You must notify Outdoor Recreation of cancellation in writing prior to the picnic date.
- 4. When coming to APG for an FMWR sponsored event All Non-DoD ID card guests over the age of 18 must register for access. This can be done at the Visitor Center Monday-Friday or online at AIE Online Web registration site: https://pass.aie.army.mil/apg Failure to obtain a pass prior to the event day will result in delays in access at the gate.
- 5. Please be aware: If you have not reserved the entire facility then there may be other customers utilizing the area. For reservations at Shore Park, if you have not reserved all 3 pavilions, there may other customer at the remaining pavilions, each pavilion holds 100 people.
- 6. Patrons are responsible for leaving the pavilions a clean condition, free from any debris or litter. All trash and disposable items must be carried out or placed in the centrally located dumpster next to the pool. It is advised to bring additional trash bags to compensate for excess trash. **NO GLASS CONTANIERS**
- 7. All charcoals must be cooled and discarded properly in the designated areas
- 8. Code to the keys will be given the business day prior or the day of the event
- 9. Music must be played at reasonable noise levels
- 10. All picnic tables must be placed back in the designated pavilion in the way in which they were found
- 11. NO pets are permitted at the picnic areas
- 12. Park in designated parking areas only within the park. Blocking the entrance and exit to the picnic area/campground is prohibited. Park area is shared with campground patrons.
- 13. Users of APGMWR Picnic Areas and its amenities do so at their own risk
- 14. All game items must be returned or placed where they were received from to include outdoor recreation equipment
