

The Recreational Lodging facilities collectively consist of 185 **single-occupant rooms**. These units are furnished and offer private bath, hook-up for basic cable, kitchenette and closet space in select buildings. Additionally, BLDG 4316 has internet installed throughout the building. Each building has a laundry room with 4 washers and 4 dryers. All facilities are adequately furnished and will vary by facility. Each facility offers a well-lit parking area for tenants.

General Information

-Eligibility requirements are verified at the time of check in and can be found in AR 215-1 Chapter 7 (Active Duty Military, Retired Military, DoD Civilian, and Full Time Contractors on Aberdeen Proving Ground)

-Monthly rent is taken automatically on the 15th of every month (billing period is always the 1st - 30th/31st)

-Tenants are NOT to remove furniture from the rooms.

-Final clearing of a room will need a notice of at least 2 weeks in advance.

-Pets are prohibited (this includes any living creature).

-Kitchen grease needs to be disposed properly. You are NOT permitted under any circumstances to dump grease down the drain.

-Wipes/ feminine products must be disposed of in a trash can.





IMPORTANT POLICY INFORMATION

- Facilities and free programs for ID card holders only.
- ID card checks and swipe in at each use required when entering facility
- Patron eligibility IAW AR 215-1, table 7
- Locker facilities provided at each facility. Lockers are for daily use only and locks are not provided. Bags may not be stored on the floor in the fitness equipment areas.
- During peak participation times or when individuals are waiting to use cardiovascular machines, there is a 20-minute time limit on each piece of equipment.
- Eye protection is required (and provided) by all racquetball players.
- Youth aged 15 and under must be accompanied by eligible parent/guardian and participate with/be in line of sight at all times. No strollers or child carriers are allowed in any exercise or play area.

IMPACT AID SURVEY

- Federal Impact Aid is a law that provides a way for the federal government to **reimburse local school districts** for the loss of property and business tax support associated with federally connected students residing on/off base in the district.
- The funding that your child's school receives in Impact Aid **directly impacts his or her education** by providing replacement funding for operating expenses such as materials, equipment, staff, special education programming, and building improvements as part of the general funding of the district.

What Can I Do As A Parent?

Each year your child receives a **Federal Survey Form** that requests confidential information regarding his/her federal connection (including military and civilian family members). Simply by thoroughly completing and promptly returning this brief survey, you contribute to your child's school funding!

- Incomplete surveys cannot be submitted for Impact Aid; thereby creating a loss of funding for the district.
- Information provided is protected under Privacy Laws.

Surveys are given out in the First Quarter of the school year.

The Aberdeen Proving Ground (APG) Child and Youth Services CYS Sports & Fitness program offers various opportunities for children to participate in sports. The program provides support for children ages 3-18 years to encourage healthy, life-long habits.

Team sports are only available with the participation of volunteer coaches and assistants. Team sports practices held weekdays Monday through Thursday with ages 4-10 at 5:30 and ages 11-15 at 6:30 (subject to change based on volunteer availability). Coaches are trained and certified by the National Alliance of Youth Sports (NAYS) and must have a completed background check. Players must be registered with CYS in order to enroll in a sport. Sports Physicals are good for 1 year. Summer is the best time to get sports physicals for school year.

- AFAP Listens and Acts Once an issue is received, it is reviewed by local volunteers, discussed at monthly forums, and submitted for action at the APG annual AFAP Conference.
- 3. Together We Find A Solution Although some issues take time or are proven unattainable, every issue is reviewed, monitored, and tracked until a resolution is found. Most issues can be handled locally and are sent to the appropriate directorate for resolution. Relocation Readiness Program (RRP) 410-278-4232

Focuses on ensuring support and assistance is available for inbound and outbound military personnel and their Family members. Includes: Newcomer's Orientation, Military Homefront/Military Installations Guide, Lending Closet, etc.













Mobilization and Deployment/Stability & Support Operations Readiness 410-278-2500

Provides assistance to Commanders and assigned members and their Family members in maintaining individual readiness throughout the Deployment Cycle Support (DCS) Process. The DCS provides a means to identify individuals/Family members who may need assistance with the challenges inherent to extended deployments. Training includes: Pre and Post deployment, Post-Deployment Resilience Training for Spouses/Couples. Assist Commanders organize and train Family Readiness Group (FRG) members utilizing Operation R.E.A.D.Y materials.

Survivor Outreach Service (SOS) 410-278-2435

Program provides lifetime support to Families of Fallen Soldiers. The Army is committed to ease the pain of their loss and help them through this very difficult time. Services include: Support groups (adults and children), professional financial counseling, short term grief counseling on post and referrals to outside counseling in addition to gathering and getting to know fellow Gold Star Families.

Victim Advocacy Program (VAP) 410-278-1305 24/7 HELP LINE: 410-652-6048

Provides victims of domestic violence and sexual assault with a variety of services and support designed to increase victim safety and maximize autonomy. These services include: Crisis Intervention, Options Counseling, Safety Planning, Legal Advocacy, Court Accompaniment, Emergency Shelter Placement, Emergency Transportation, Relocation Assistance, Emotional and Command Support.



Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) 410-278-2420

This program is in all branches of the service. Its mission is to assist Active Duty Personnel with Family members who have physical, emotional, developmental, or intellectual needs who require special treatment, therapy, education, training, and equipment or building modifications. EFMP is designed to minimize the disruptions those needs might have upon the Family during relocation, and to give considerations to those needs in the reassignment process through medical and education evaluations.

Family Advocacy Program (FAP) 410-278-7478

Designed to break the cycle of spouse/ intimate partner and child abuse by identifying abuse as early as possible and by providing prevention and intervention services and resources for affected Soldiers, Family Members, and DoD Civilians. FAP services are also available to individuals who just want to gain the skills necessary to improve self and relationships.

Financial Readiness Program (FRP) 410-278-2453

Developed to educate on personal financial management. Services provided are budget counseling, debt liquidation plans, consumer education and information, explaining credit, and help in developing savings habits. Consumer assistance is offered in cases involving conflict with local businesses. In all cases, counseling is provided on an individual and confidential basis.

Information and Referral (I&R) 410-278-7572

This office serves as the central distribution point for ACS information, flyers, brochures and upcoming events and activities. We maintain an extensive resource file of local public, private and voluntary agencies and organizations to assist individuals with getting the support or information they need. This program will also direct you to our computer lab that allows you to access information via Wi-Fi or CAC capabilities.
